

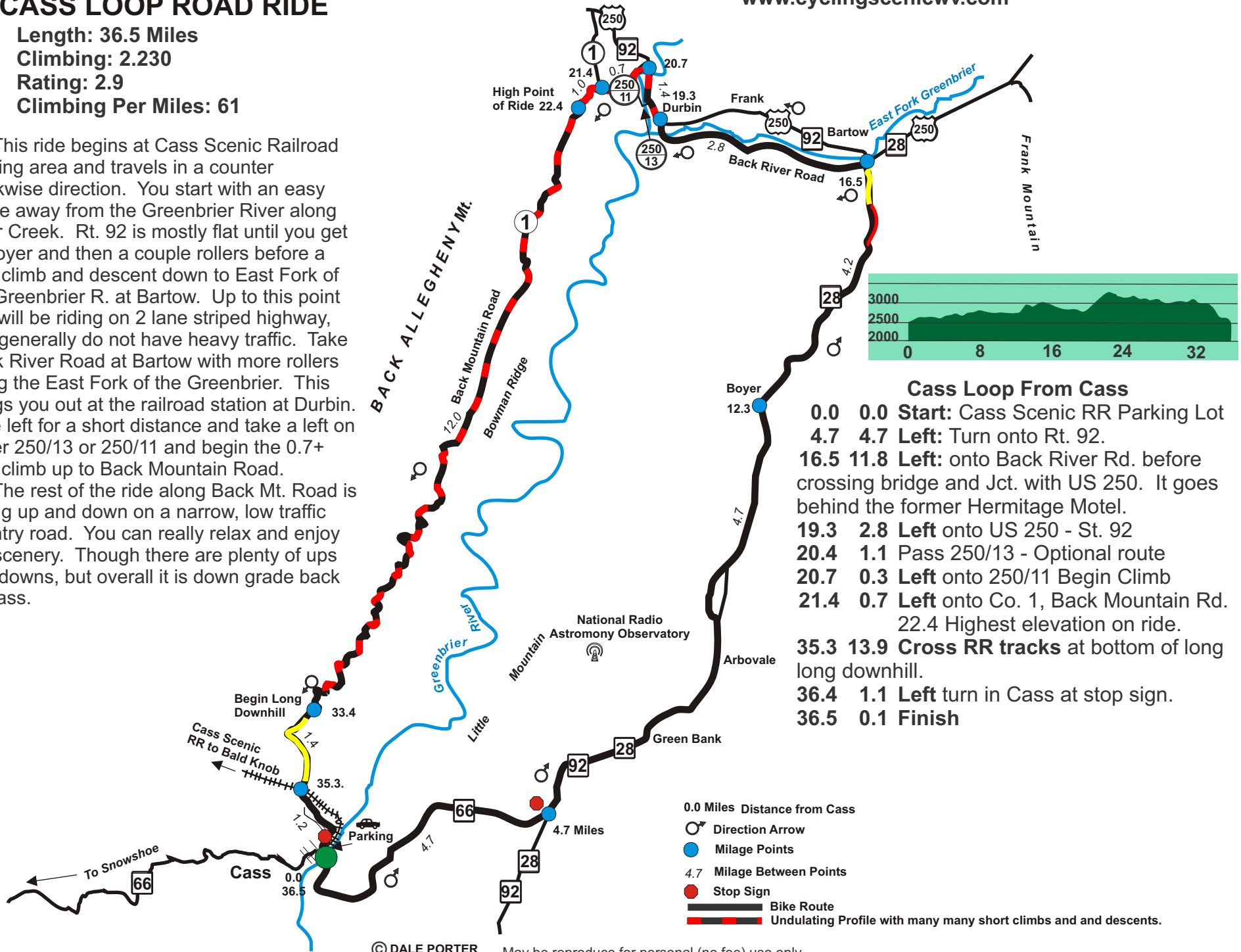
CASS LOOP ROAD RIDE

Length: 36.5 Miles
 Climbing: 2.230
 Rating: 2.9
 Climbing Per Miles: 61

This ride begins at Cass Scenic Railroad parking area and travels in a counter clockwise direction. You start with an easy grade away from the Greenbrier River along Deer Creek. Rt. 92 is mostly flat until you get to Boyer and then a couple rollers before a mild climb and descent down to East Fork of the Greenbrier R. at Bartow. Up to this point you will be riding on 2 lane striped highway, that generally do not have heavy traffic. Take Back River Road at Bartow with more rollers along the East Fork of the Greenbrier. This brings you out at the railroad station at Durbin. Bare left for a short distance and take a left on either 250/13 or 250/11 and begin the 0.7+ mile climb up to Back Mountain Road.

The rest of the ride along Back Mt. Road is rolling up and down on a narrow, low traffic country road. You can really relax and enjoy the scenery. Though there are plenty of ups and downs, but overall it is down grade back to Cass.
